# New Duel Shoot

You shoot against your chosen partner in a “duel.” Winner advances to a duel with another winner, loser continues in a losers bracket, that way everyone gets at least two chances to participate.

## Here are the rules:

- 1) Partner up with somebody
- 2) Choose your weapons: any traditional, iron sighted pistol, rifled or smoothbore, being flintlock or percussion firing a single round ball patched or otherwise or any traditional, iron sighted long gun firing a patched round ball. Once you have chosen a weapon you are stuck with it for the rest of the contest.
- 3) Target is an 8”-12” sheet of blank white paper. No lines, aiming points or reference marks of any kind are to be on this paper.
- 4) You get one and only one shot. It must be your first shot of the day, no foulers, sighters, or practice rounds. You arrive at the range, post your target, load your piece, and fire. You’re done.
- 5) Target is to be set at 25 yards for pistols and 50 yards for long guns. Target is to be fired on from an official unsupported position. Pistol shooters may use 2 hands.
- 6) After firing your shot, use a pencil or pen. Draw lines from each corner of the paper forming an “X” in the center. Measure the distance from the center of the “X” to the center of your ball. Report the results to Duel Coordinator. Scoring hint: measure to edge of shot and add ½ ball diameter.
- 7) If you miss the target entirely you must still report the result of your shot.
- 8) The shooter with the closest shot to the center will advance to the winners bracket, the loser will move into a losers bracket.
- 9) If both shooters miss the target completely, or have same measurement from center, the target must be reshot or winner is chosen from coin toss.
- 10) If only one shooter post a target in the allotted time, they will win by default even if they miss the target.
- 11) After first round is complete, the Duel Coordinator will pair up the next round by drawing names from a hat. Both winners and losers will be chosen in the same manner. If there is a name left over, they will automatically get a BYE and advance into the next round.
- 12) The final shoot off will be between the winners of the two brackets (the winner will be in the Burrs class, the losers will be in the Hamilton class).
