**Per Meeting Discussion** - Important safety notes for all AHC members:

- A. Always carry your rifle in an upright position in the club area, and treat it as if it was fully loaded.
- B. If someone hands you a rifle that may be loaded, do not attempt to shoot it. You don't know what kind and how much powder may be in it. "Some fool" might have loaded it (in a worst case scenario) with pistol powder (such as bull's eye), had a misfire, and put the gun away. Firing the rifle, could be a disaster not only for you, but anyone standing near you. Think of a grenade going off!
- C. Remember to keep your hands and face clear, of the muzzle, in the common event such as a hanging fire. When in doubt, call a range officer for advice and help.
- D. Please make our sport safe. Shooting is not a game, but a sport!

After shooting your target, look at it! Count the holes and **if there is question, like double holes**, have a range officer look at it. The Range Officer should sign and state on the target, how many holes there are in the particular spot in question. **Only then**, take the target off the board, turn your target in, and you will receive credit for it. Thank you for your understanding!
