- R.O.'s were issued whistles to be used in the event of an emergency. The sound of a whistle on the line means danger!
- The First Aid Kit has been updated. Actually, there are two – one by the kitchen and one behind the counter on top of the file cabinet. Let Jim Penland know if you use supplies from either kit so it can be replenished.
- AHC's range commands have been reworded to reflect new wording from Friendship.
- When moving up and down the range, keep rifles vertical with the muzzle above the level of your head.
- At the end of the last relay, there is to be no cleaning or handling of rifles until ALL shooters are off the range with their targets and backer boards.
- CVA's new electric ignition rifle is not allowed on the shooting line - at Alabama, or NMLRA.
- Scoring of a claimed double hole will ONLY be done by R.O.'s out on the range. Scoring officers inside the club house WILL NOT score for double holes without a signed target from a R.O.
