The following was written by Tench Coxe in 1788. It is part of one of a series of articles he wrote and published in the Philadelphia Gazette discussing the then newly adopted Constitution of the United States of America. Today, many defend the right to keep and bear arms in terms of sporting use and self defense. Don't forget that our nation's independence was won by a citizen army whose soldiers privately owned the same armament as the oppressive government it was overthrowing! I am sure this fact was foremost in the minds of the writers of our constitution when they reaffirmed our inalienable birthright to keep and bear arms. All arms.

*“The power of the sword, say the minority of Pennsylvania, is in the hands of Congress. My friends and countrymen, it is not so, for THE POWERS OF THE SWORD ARE IN THE HANDS OF THE YEOMANRY OF AMERICA FROM SIXTEEN TO SIXTY. The militia of these free commonwealths, entitled and accustomed to their arms, when compared with any possible army, must be tremendous and irresistible. Who are the militia? are they not ourselves. Is it feared, then that we shall turn our arms each man against his own bosom. Congress have no power to disarm the militia. Their swords, and every other terrible implement of the soldier, are the birth-right of an American. What clause in the state or federal constitution hath given away that important right. . . . [T]he unlimited power of the sword is not in the hands of either the federal or state governments, but where I trust in God it will ever remain, in the hands of the people.”*
