**June Shoot** – The next monthly shoot is Sunday, June 1. Range Officers shoot at 9:00 a.m. and the general membership shoots at 11:00 a.m. This the annual ‘novelty’ shoot. Be prepared to move safely along the line to shoot at the various targets.

**Political Action** – In response to an e-mail regarding the onerous gun restrictions proposed by the State Assembly, New York State Senator George Maziarz stated that the bills had no chance of passing the Senate. It is interesting that all of these bills passed the Assembly by large margins (close to 2 to 1). Please contact your assemblyman(woman) and express your opinion. If these bills become law, all guns .50 caliber or larger would be **outlawed**. This includes your Hawkens, smoothbores and 12 and 20 gauge shotguns!

**Sporter Rifle** – Will meet on Monday nights at 6:30 p.m. beginning June 2. Shoots will run until August 25. You must compete in 10 shoots to qualify for a prize. Bring something to lay on for the prone and sitting positions. Bring any .22 rifle, but remember that you will be shooting 20 shots offhand while standing.

**Safety Concern** –Trees used for wood to repair the backer boards were taken from behind the berm. There was a large amount of lead found in the trees – round ball and shaped. Many of us have seen branches knocked out of the trees past the 200 yard line – some branches as high as 30’. This means rounds are bouncing over both the 100 and 200 yard berms. To lessen the effect of bouncing rounds, please staple your targets high up on your backer board.
